### Eligibility:

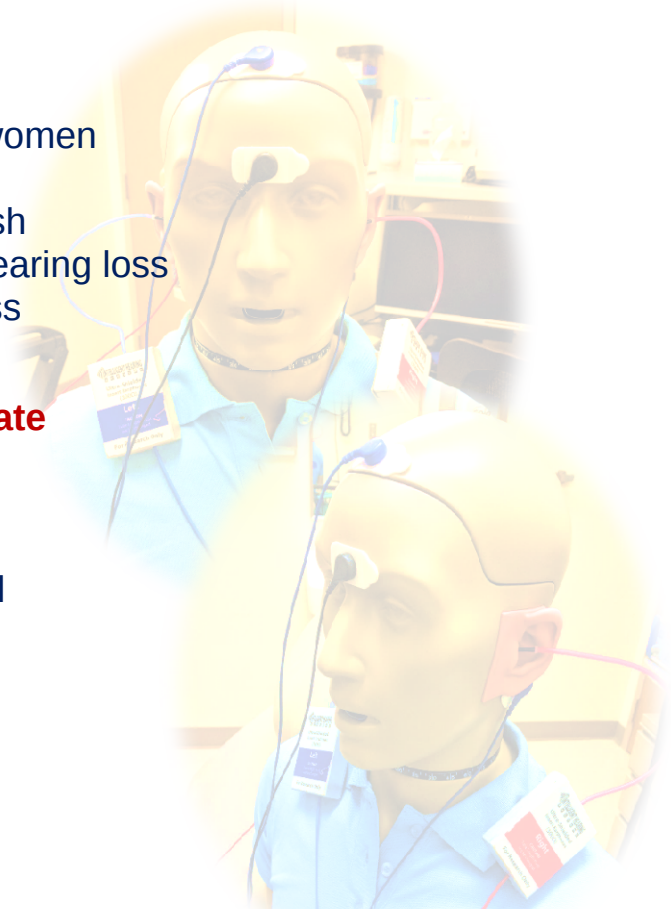
- DEERS-eligible servicemen and women
